
Paying for your holiday: Making living better with dementia more affordable.

The per person price quoted here is for the **first holiday** booked in a calendar year. It represents a considerably lower price than the actual cost. If you would like to take a second or subsequent holiday in the year, the cost will be **approximately 30% more**, but you will need to call us to ask for a quote. As a charity we raise funds to provide this help and keep our costs down by recruiting and training volunteers who are valuable members of our support team. They will do all they can to help you have an enjoyable and supported break. We take a £100 pp deposit to secure a booking, and then send you an invoice for the balance 2 months before the holiday begins.

What's Included?


The cost includes all accommodation, transport, food and drinks at the accommodation and excursions but does not include alcoholic drinks, or tea, coffee and snacks when out and about. Transport from home in our vehicle can usually be arranged at an extra cost. We may also be able to arrange for a member of our team to meet you at your home and escort you on the train journey to your holiday accommodation. Personal care can sometimes be arranged at extra cost if required and must be arranged in advance.

There are spaces for up to 4 pairs of people on each holiday, and we must have at least 3 couples for the trip to go ahead, so please book early. If we have to cancel a holiday, which will be about 8 weeks ahead of the departure date, your booking can be transferred to another trip.








